This year, artists, authors, crafters, and vendors will be located alongside Railroad Avenue nestled between the finest shopping locations for the perfect items for Christmas. To add to your shopping experience, activities including the Donaldsonville Fire Department Association Children's Christmas Village with Santa Claus, Christmas Caroling, and live music, arts, and crafts will be featured throughout the event on Railroad Avenue, including Lil Wayne and the Same Ole 2 Step Zydeco Band near the Square (5:30pm - 7:30pm), Kenny Fife at Donaldsonville Glass and Body Works, the Avenue Cruisers at the Grapevine (reservations recommended), live music at Donaldsonville's newest Breakfast and Bistro, Mawmaw Tootsies (420 Mississippi Street), and Artemis ends the night at Gaston's Pub. New to the Stroll this year at the River Road African American Museum's Gospel and Gumbo will be a Freedom Lantern Tour, gumbo tasting and a cake walk at the Museum and Bicentennial Jazz Plaza. Also, join the museum to meet the legendary File Man and get your fresh Louisiana File for the holidays (\$25 Adults/\$10 Children/Children Under 6 Free). And don't miss Framer Dave's for delicious gumbo, music, car show, and live painting with the talented artist Alvin Batiste. Also, stop by the Avenue's Refreshments, food and beverage will be provided at our local area restaurants. Like previous years, Railroad Avenue will be closed to traffic, and the Stroll Trolley returns. Parking is available on side streets.



Please make arrangements to bring your own tent, tables, and chairs. Power may be limited so please be certain to let us know if you have power needs. Vendors ARE NOT ALLOWED to set up in front of any open or participating merchant location UNLESS YOU HAVE PRIOR PERMISSION. Please inform me of such arrangements in advance. Railroad Avenue will be closed to traffic again this year. Setup is encouraged as early as 3:30pm. Tear down will take place as soon as the event is over OR as patrons are no longer present.
